### Technical Job Training Program

There are three requirements all participants must have:

1. High School Diploma or GED certification
2. Durham county residency
3. Sponsor agent or agency (Training coordinator will provide information on being a sponsor.)

The training program will consist of three eight-week modules (sessions):

#### Module One

- Employability/Soft Skills
- Personal Development
- Financial Management
- Basic Computing

#### Module Two

- Leadership Development
- Intermediate Computer Skills
- Warehouse technician and on-the-job training classes

#### Module Three

- Academic goal-centered classes
- Expanded hours spent in the training warehouse

Students enrolled in the training program will be eligible to receive a bi-weekly Financial Assistance Package. More information is available during orientation. This is along with other non-monetary incentives.

Priority will be given to individuals recommended by organizations that are members of DERC. There is no charge for participants that meet the eligibility requirements.
